

Toilet Tube Butterfly

Here's how to make this pretty toilet tube butterfly. All you Need is some paint, scissors, glue and 2 x toilet tubes.



- 1. Paint one toilet tube in your preferred colour.
- 2. Leave the tube to dry then flatten and cut off 4 x 1.5cm wide rings and 1 x 0.5cm-wide ring.
- 3. Take the 4x 1.5cm rings and make 2 of them smaller by cutting it at one of the folded creases to break the ring, and cut off a 1cm strip from the end. Tape the ring back together to make smaller rings.
- 4. Arrange the four rings into a butterfly shape, with the two larger pieces on top and stick them together.
- 5. Take the 0.5cm ring and cut it in half, curl the ends round to make the antennae and stick on the top two wings.
- 6. Cut the second tube in half and paint each half a different colour.
- 7. Cut the two tubes in half and bend into your preferred shape.
- 8. Then stick them inside the 4 wings and your butterfly is complete!
