




## Make your own castle

This homemade castle is the perfect play tool for developing children's imagination! All you need to make this super easy castle are 2 sheets of paper, coloured pens, 4 x toilet rolls, sellotape and a pipe cleaner.

- 1.) Decorate your 4 toilet rolls which will act as the castle's towers
- 2.) Cut out 2 x rectangles (12cm x 7cm) in your preferred coloured paper and decorate one with a front door and the other with 3 narrow windows.
- 3.) Cut out 2 smaller rectangles for the sides of the castle (10cm x 5cm).
- 4.) Fold down the 2 ends of the pieces of paper and sellotape each end to a toilet tube.
- 5.) Cut out four circles that are the same size as the sellotape and curve them into cones.
- 6.) Stick the cones on top of each toilet tube to act as turrets.
- 7.) Chop a pipe cleaner into 4 pieces to act as poles for the flags.







- 8.) Cut our 4 paper flags and sellotape them to the top of each pipe cleaner piece.
- 9.) Then, insert the flags through the top of the cones and your castle is complete!
