

Counting Caterpillar

This cardboard caterpillar is great for improving children's counting. Get your child to count each circle as one body part up to 10! All you need is paint, card, scissors, pipe cleaners and blu tack.

- 1. Draw 10 circles, making sure that one is significantly bigger than the others.
- 2. Paint all the circles a different colour
- 3. On the biggest circle, draw on a face.
- 4. Cut 2 even parts of a pipe cleaner off and bend to make the antennae. Then stick them onto the caterpillar's head.
- 5. Finally, using blu tack, add each circle to create a full caterpillar, counting up to 10! Remember to use blu tack instead of glue to allow your child to play with the craft again.
