



Make your own envelope

Through role play, children can pretend to work in a post office and can develop their creativity and fine motor skills as they make their own paper envelopes like this. All you need is a square sheet of paper, a pen and a stamp!

- Fold a square piece of paper in half horizontally, and then again vertically.
- Fold in one side of the paper to the middle of that side of the page and turn down the corners.
- Then, turn in the top and bottom sides
- Fold the two corners on the left side so they meet in the middle.
- And finally, tuck the folded triangle into the pocket to complete your envelope!
- To add decoration, simply stick on a stamp and write on an address.
